



A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND CHAPTER 21, REVISED ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU 1990, AS AMENDED (THE LAND USE ORDINANCE), RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL FENCES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to increase the allowable height of fences on certain agricultural lands.

SECTION 2. Section 21-4.30, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 ("Yards and street setbacks"), is amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

"(c) Other than retaining walls, walls and fences up to a height of six feet may project into or enclose any part of a required yard, except that:

- (1) They shall be prohibited in front yards in business, business mixed use, industrial, and industrial- commercial mixed use districts.
- (2) Walls and fences constructed by public utilities may be up to eight feet in height, and may be topped with security wire to a total height of nine feet.
- (3) Special district regulations under Article 9 may provide for other restrictions.
- (4) Fences located on land dedicated for agricultural use pursuant to Section 8-7.3 may be up to ten feet in height."

SECTION 3. New ordinance material is underscored. When revising, compiling, or printing this ordinance for inclusion in the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, the revisor of ordinances need not include the underscoring.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




