

Subject: North Shore Sustainable Communities Plan Update

The State Department of Transportation (DOT) previously commented on the North Shore Sustainable Communities Plan Update in its letter STP 8.0267 dated October 25, 2010 (attached). DOT now offers the following supplemental comments.

1. Section 4.1.1 Roadway Network, Page 4-4. The statement, "The STIP is presently being updated" should be expanded to address the fact that projects being identified are not definitive. The identified projects do not have a fixed timeline and is subject to change.
2. Section 4.1.3 Bikeway System, Page 4-5. The statement, "The Signed Shared Roadway, according..." should be revised to "The Signed Shared Roadway, according to the Bike Plan Hawaii, is ... the preferred route for bicycle use, which is mainly due to lane width or other mitigating factors."
