



RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING THE CITY COUNCIL'S CONTINUING SUPPORT FOR THE SHIPMENT ON AN INTERIM BASIS OF SOLID WASTE OUT-OF-STATE.

WHEREAS, the shipment of city solid waste out-of-state to the mainland or internationally on an interim basis is a possible alternative to our continued reliance on the dwindling space remaining at the city's municipal solid waste landfill at Waimanalo Gulch; and

WHEREAS, implementation of new technology and/or the site selection, development and permitting process of a new landfill could take many years; and

WHEREAS, in the recent past, the Council has appropriated substantial funding to implement out-of-state transport of the city's municipal solid waste; and

WHEREAS, delays in implementing solid waste shipping have occurred due to various contractual and permitting issues; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 09-227, CD1, the Council established city policies on the shipment of solid waste out-of-state; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that it expresses its continuing support for the shipment of solid waste out-of-state to the mainland or internationally as an interim method of refuse disposal; and
