Mr. Chair:

Your Committee on Budget, which considered Bill 16 (2011) entitled:

“A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CITY HALL AND SATELLITE  
OFF-STREET PARKING,”

transmitted by Communication MM-36, dated March 2, 2011, from the Office of the Mayor, and which passed first reading at the March 16, 2011 Council meeting, reports as follows:

The purpose of the Bill is to revise the parking permit fees for City Hall and satellite off-street parking.

Your Committee considered a proposed posted CD1 version that adds the employee parking at Kapolei Hale and the Blaisdell Center as designated parking areas.

The Director of the Department of Budget and Fiscal Services expressed the Administration’s concerns with the proposed CD1 version regarding the fees assessed to city employees who park at the Blaisdell Center. Director Hansen noted that the parking fees collected at this facility is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Enterprise Services not the Department of Facility Maintenance as described in the Bill. Director Hansen also noted that the Administration is currently reviewing parking fees at Kapolei Hale but there is no formal proposal at this time.

Councilmember Anderson expressed the desire to establish one set fee structure for City employee parking versus the tiered parking structure currently in the proposed bill.


Committee Vice Chair Gabbard Tamayo stated that parking fees should be fair and equitable across the board and the Council should look at establishing a set fee structure for all employees.

## A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

---

RELATING TO CITY HALL AND SATELLITE OFF-STREET PARKING.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to revise the parking permit fees for City Hall and satellite off-street parking.

SECTION 2. Section 15-16.5, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 ("City Hall and satellite off-street parking"), is hereby amended by amending subsections (d) and (e) read as follows:

"(d) Except as specified otherwise, the chief engineer of the department of facility maintenance is authorized to designate by appropriate signs and/or markings all parking areas described in this subsection for the exclusive use of officials and employees of the city and employees of the civic center child care facility. The chief engineer is authorized to issue parking permits under this section, upon receiving application therefor on forms furnished by the chief engineer and payment of the applicable monthly permit fee described in subsection (e). The designated parking areas are as follows:

(1) The areas designated as parking spaces for city employees at Kapolei Hale;

[(1)] (2) Except for off-street parking areas serving fire stations and fire repair facilities, all city off-street parking areas in the area bounded by Ward Avenue, Kinau Street, Lusitana Street, H-1 Freeway, Nuuanu Stream, North Nimitz Highway, South Nimitz Highway and Ala Moana Boulevard. These parking areas are under the jurisdiction of the department of facility maintenance.

[(2)] (3) The Alapai parking facility located at the Waikiki makai corner of Alapai and Beretania Streets, which includes areas P-1, P-2, P-3, B-1 and B-2[, is]. These parking areas are under the jurisdiction of the chief of police. The chief of police of the city is authorized and directed to designate all parking areas by appropriate signs and/or markings for the exclusive use of officials and employees of the city. The chief of police is authorized to issue, upon receipt of an application therefor on forms furnished by the chief of police and payment of the applicable monthly parking fee, permits for parking in the facility described in this subdivision.

[(3)] (4) The chief engineer and the chief of police may charge a fee of \$15.00 for each parking decal that is replaced due to being lost, stolen, misplaced or not returned.”

“(e) Any city official or employee, including any elective or appointive official, and any employee of the civic center child care facility, who applies for and receives a parking permit under this section shall pay a fee for parking in accordance with the following schedule:

From July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012:

Assigned covered stall .....	[\$50.00]	<u>\$63.00</u> per month
Assigned covered stall assigned to an elected or appointed official or employee of the city .....	[\$75.00]	<u>\$88.00</u> per month
Unassigned covered stall .....	[\$35.00]	<u>\$48.00</u> per month
Assigned tandem covered stall .....	[\$25.00]	<u>\$38.00</u> per month
Assigned uncovered stall .....	[\$40.00]	<u>\$53.00</u> per month
Unassigned uncovered stall .....	[\$25.00]	<u>\$38.00</u> per month
Unassigned uncovered satellite stall with bus pass for commuting to working place not less than 3/8 mile away .....	[\$20.00]	<u>\$33.00</u> per month
Assigned tandem uncovered stall .....	[\$15.00]	<u>\$28.00</u> per month
Carpool unassigned covered or uncovered stalls:		
Two occupants .....		75% of specified rate
Three occupants.....		50% of specified rate
Four or more occupants .....		No Charge.



A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

From July 1, 2012;

Unassigned covered stall shall be at the same rate as the fare for an adult monthly bus pass as provided for in Section 13-2.1, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended;

Assigned covered stall shall be \$15 more than the unassigned covered stalls per month;

Assigned covered stall assigned to an elected or appointed official or employee of the city shall be \$40 more than the rate for unassigned covered stalls per month;

Assigned tandem covered stall shall be \$10 less than the rate for unassigned covered stalls per month;

Assigned uncovered stall shall be \$5 more than the rate for unassigned covered stalls per month;

Unassigned uncovered stall shall be \$10 less than the rate for unassigned covered stalls per month;

Unassigned uncovered satellite stall with bus pass for commuting to working place not less than 3/8 mile away shall be \$15 less than the rate for unassigned covered stalls per month;

Assigned tandem uncovered stall shall be \$20 less than the rate for unassigned covered stalls per month;

Carpool unassigned covered or uncovered stalls:

Two occupants ..... 75% of specified rate

Three occupants..... 50% of specified rate

Four or more occupants ..... No Charge.”

SECTION 3. Ordinance material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. When revising, compiling, or printing this ordinance for inclusion in the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, the revisor of ordinances need not include the brackets, the bracketed material or the underscoring.
