I am writing in support of Bill 5 which would amend city ordinance to prohibit the conduct of commercial activities in all city parks on Sundays. My mother lives in Lanikai and I live in Kailua. It is impossible to pass by Kailua Beach Park on a Sunday without seeing the fire department rescuing someone and/or HPD ticketing. What available space exists on the grassy areas is soon covered with large canopy tents for parties and bounce houses for children's birthdays. To the extent that commercial operators are erecting these structures on Sundays in our parks, I hope Bill 5 would preclude them. Fund raising booths in the beach parks on Sundays during canoe races are about the only exception I could see being made to this ordinance. Mahalo, Yuklin Aluli
