Your Committee on Parks and Cultural Affairs, to which was referred Resolution 11-370 entitled:

"RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND RECREATION OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE GARDEN CLUB OF HONOLULU FOR THE TROPICAL FOREST CHILDREN'S PROGRAM AT HO'OMALUHIA BOTANICAL GARDEN,"

transmitted by Departmental Communication No. 785 from the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR), dated December 27, 2011, reports as follows:

The purpose of this Resolution is to authorize the DPR Director or his designated representatives to accept the \$3,000 grant from the Garden Club for uses at the Ho'omaluhia Botanical Garden to: 1) purchase books related to plant and environmental education; 2) install signage that provides specific text and visual information on tropical forest plants along the garden pathway; and 3) provide photo booklets replicating the information on the signage which would be included in the children's library to encourage further research on the tropical forest trail plantings.

Your Committee heard supporting testimony from the DPR Director.
