



RESOLUTION

ACCEPTING A GIFT TO THE CITY TO PARTICIPATE IN A "YOUNG LEADERS POLITICAL TRAINING" EVENT IN COPENHAGEN, DENMARK.

WHEREAS, Section 13-113 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu, as revised, provides the City Council with sole authority to accept gifts on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, in an e-mail dated March 9, 2012 to Councilmember Stanley Chang, the U.S. Department of State, Copenhagen's Mayor for Integration, and the Danish-Ethnic Youth Council have extended an invitation to Councilmember Chang to participate in a "Young Leaders Political Training" event to be held from April 22nd to April 24th, 2012 at Copenhagen City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of State ("Donor") has offered to pay all costs of the training event, including air and ground transportation, hotel accommodations, and meal expenses, at a total cost of about \$2,500; and

WHEREAS, the description and value of the gift is set forth in the Declaration of Gift form attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the stated purpose of the invitation and gift is to bring together young elected political and civil society leaders from across Europe and United States from ethnic and religious minority groups to discuss and learn about practices that will facilitate inclusive governments. This event is a transatlantic networking and training opportunity for young ethnic and religious minority political and civil society leaders, being held in cooperation with the Transatlantic Minority Political Leadership Conference and the U.S. Congressional Taskforce for Inclusive Governments; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that the Council hereby accepts a gift to the City from the U.S. Department of State for the costs of transportation, accommodations, and meal expenses for one City Councilmember (Councilmember Stanley Chang) to attend and participate in the "Young Leaders Political Training" event to be held from April 22nd to April 24th, 2012 in Copenhagen, Denmark; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council expresses its deep appreciation to the U.S. Department of State for this generous gift to the City; and




