


Subject: Request for Council Acceptance of a Gift to the City of Artwork



RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT OF ARTWORK FROM DON DUGAL TO THE CITY FOR THE ART IN CITY BUILDINGS COLLECTION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU MANAGED BY THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF CULTURE AND THE ARTS.

WHEREAS, Don Dugal wishes to gift a painting to the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, the painting entitled "Moanalua Light" by the donor, Don Dugal, is an acrylic on canvas painting measuring 19 feet wide by five feet high composed of four separate equally sized panels designed to abut each other, completed in 1973; and

WHEREAS, the painting was executed in the early years of the artist's 44 year Honolulu residency and was in response to the magnificent trees of Moanalua Gardens and the special light of an Island Night; and

WHEREAS, "Moanalua Light" was first exhibited in the Honolulu Advertiser Gallery in 1973; and later included in the juried 59th Michigan Artists Exhibition of 1974 at the Detroit Institute of Arts for which it received the Albert Kahn Associates, Inc. Architects and Engineers Prize for a "Work suitable to an architectural setting;" and was later exhibited in two different Faculty Exhibitions at the University of Hawaii at Manoa Art Gallery; and


WHEREAS, the Commission on Culture and the Arts approved to respectfully request the acceptance of this gift by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu at their meeting on March 8, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-113 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu provided for the acceptance of gifts given to City executive agencies; and

WHEREAS, the policy provided for acceptance of the gift by affirmative action by the Council; and

WHEREAS, through a letter the Executive Director of the Mayor's Office of Culture and the Arts has submitted a request to the Council of the gift valued at \$10,000.00 for the Art in City Buildings collection; and

WHEREAS, the description and value of the gift are set forth in the Declaration of Gift attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein; now therefore,


