I am very **opposed** to Bill 11 as it exists today, and I am in favor of the bill before it was amended. My key points regardless of what **the few** 1200 think:

- Kailua and Lanikai are not GATED COMMUNITIES. They are neighborhoods in Honolulu County in the State of Hawaii. The beaches are public land, and are intended to be used by residents AND visitors.
- Some regulation is necessary to satisfy both residents and visitors. Keep the licensing permit. Enforce the ordinance by self regulation in the industry.
- The petition signers wanting to ban all beach use are a small coalition of people who would like the Pali tunnel to be closed and keep anyone but themselves out of Kailua.
- The Kailua Neighborhood Board vote on issues represents their point of view and not the community at large.

Do not give these people the power to bully the rest of us on this or any more issues.
