This resolution to sell our public parkland is a step down the wrong path.

Please do not approve this resolution. Condemnation of land for a specific, and well-needed, public purpose (public park land) should not lead to a contrary purpose (private development).

It's as simple as that.

Given the tremendous community stewardship taking place now (through the Hui o hee nalu's adopt a park agreement) and the several organizations that have come forward with offers to help the City maintain and manage this land, there is no creditable reason to carry out a bidding scheme that is not designed for complete public usage.

Allowing this resolution to pass would be abandonment of the public's trust in fair government procedures.
