

Subject: RESOLUTION TO REQUEST TRANSFER FROM PROVISIONAL
ACCOUNT TO MATCH THE OAHU METROPOLITAN PLANNING
ORGANIZATION (OahuMPO) GRANT

The Department of Facility Maintenance (DFM) respectfully requests your approval of the attached resolution authorizing the transfer of funds from the FY 2013 Operating Budget, Ordinance 12-19, Section 10, Provision for Grants, Partnerships and Security to DFM Road Maintenance Division.

The resolution is needed to transfer \$40,000 from the provisional account to match a grant from the Oahu Metropolitan Planning Organization (OahuMPO). This grant was previously approved by City Council through Resolution 12-96 on May 9, 2012.

DFM, through the Department of Transportation Services, has applied for and received a \$1,378,686 grant from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) through OahuMPO's Fiscal Year (FY) 2013-2014 Overall Work Program (OWP). DFM will conduct the following transportation planning study:

- Roadway Surface Condition Assessment and Repair Plan that will allow DFM to gather the necessary data and implement a Pavement Management System to cost effectively manage the condition of the City and County's streets.

The OWP is a document mandated by the FHWA and the FTA for metropolitan planning areas. It describes all metropolitan transportation planning activities, and

documents those planning activities to be performed with federal highway and transit funds. The OWP is prepared annually by OahuMPO in cooperation with its participating agencies.

DFM's grant application budget outlined a City match; however, DFM did not budget matching funds because there was no assurance of receiving the grant award for the project. It is the intent of the DFM to supply this twenty percent match with a combination of City personnel and funds. The personnel funding is planned to be \$288,686, with the City providing \$40,000 in funds.

RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE EXECUTIVE OPERATING BUDGET AND PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013, ORDINANCE NO. 12-19, SECTION 10, MISCELLANEOUS PROVISION FOR GRANTS, PARTNERSHIPS AND SECURITY, AND THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FACILITY MAINTENANCE FOR THE ROADWAY SURFACE CONDITION ASSESSMENT AND REPAIR PLAN.

WHEREAS, Section 2-17.2(c)(1), Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended, requires that the City Council approve by resolution any transfer of funds between activities whenever the cumulative amount of transfers from or to an activity totals in excess of \$100,000.00 or ten percent of the amount appropriated for that activity in the executive operating budget ordinance, as may be amended, whichever is less; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Facility Maintenance (DFM) was awarded a grant approved by Resolution 12-96 to create a system for Roadway Surface Condition Assessment and Repair Planning by developing a Pavement Management System; and

WHEREAS, this grant will provide for a total project cost of \$1,378,686.00 of which \$1,050,000.00 is the federal cost share and \$328,686.00 is the local cost share, consisting of \$288,686.00 of staff labor and \$40,000.00 in matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu's local cost share amount of \$40,000.00 in matching funds, is not provided for in the DFM's current Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Provision for Grants, Partnerships and Security line item in Section 10 of Ordinance No. 12-19 for fiscal year 2013 provides funding to match state or general grants to agencies that do not have matching funds provided in the current Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, a transfer of \$40,000.00 for the City and County of Honolulu's grant share amount from the Provision for Grants, Partnerships and Security line item is required to meet the grant program needs of the DFM; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that \$40,000 in General Fund monies be transferred between the following activities:
