



RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF PAMELA TAYLOR TONGG TO SERVE ON THE COMMISSION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

WHEREAS, Chapter 3, Article 2, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended (ROH), establishes the Commission on Culture and the Arts to assist the City in attaining national preeminence in culture and the arts, to assist the City in the preservation of the artistic and cultural heritages of all its people, to promote a community environment which provides equal and abundant opportunity for exposure to culture and the arts in all its forms, and to encourage and provide equal opportunity for the development of cultural and artistic talents of the people of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is comprised of 11 voting members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council to five-year terms, and other ex officio, non-voting members; and

WHEREAS, ROH Section 3-2.2 requires ten of the appointed members to represent a particular cultural or artistic category and one appointed member as an at-large representative; and

WHEREAS, by Mayor's Message 98 (2012), the Mayor has appointed Pamela Taylor Tongg to serve on the Commission as the representative of the dance category, which is one of the listed cultural or artistic categories; and

WHEREAS, if confirmed by the Council, Ms. Taylor Tongg will serve for a term to expire on June 30, 2017, succeeding O'Brien Eselu, who served as the representative of the dance category and whose term expired on June 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-103, Revised Charter of Honolulu 1973, as amended (RCH), which applies to the Commission on Culture and the Arts, includes a general qualification requiring a member to be a registered voter of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the qualifications and character of Pamela Taylor Tongg and finds that Ms. Taylor Tongg meets the requirements to serve on the Commission and deserves confirmation; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that it confirms the appointment of Pamela Taylor Tongg to serve on the Commission on Culture and the Arts as the representative of the dance category for a term expiring on June 30, 2017; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Ms. Taylor Tongg for her willingness to serve the City and County of Honolulu; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Chair of the Commission on Culture and the Arts, and Pamela Taylor Tongg.


