

Subject: Report of Gift Valued Below \$2,500 and Requested Acceptance

The Honolulu Police Department (HPD) respectfully requests the acceptance by the City Council, on behalf of the City and County of Honolulu, of a gift to the City from Mr. Dean Kapoi, Vice President, Young Brothers, Limited, of a used shipping container. This request is made under the provisions of Resolution No. 05-349, CD1, FD1. RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT TO THE CITY FOR THE HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT A GIFT OF A USED SHIPPING CONTAINER TO BE USED FOR STORAGE OF TRAINING EQUIPMENT AT THE KOKO HEAD RANGE.

WHEREAS, Section 13-113 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu provides for the acceptance of gifts to the City by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 05-349, CD1, FD1, establishes a policy of the Council for the solicitation and acceptance of gifts donated to the City executive agencies; and

WHEREAS, the policy provides that an executive agency may request the Council's immediate consideration of a request for acceptance of a gift to the City to allow the agency's time-sensitive expenditure of the gift; and

WHEREAS, the policy provides for acceptance of the gift by affirmative action by the Council; and

WHEREAS, through a letter, the Chief of Police of the Honolulu Police Department (hereinafter HPD) has submitted a request to the Council that was approved by the Managing Director for the acceptance of a gift from Mr. Dean A. Kapoi, Vice President, Young Brothers, Limited, of a used 20-foot shipping container valued at \$800. The HPD was notified of the availability of this gift on October 8, 2012, and took possession as the container would otherwise have been disposed of; and

WHEREAS, the description and value of the gift are set forth in the Declaration of Gift (Exhibit A) and incorporated herein; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that this body accepts the gift valued at \$800 that is more fully described in the above-mentioned letter from the Chief of Police of the HPD; and


