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## A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

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TO AMEND CHAPTER 9 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCE OF HONOLULU 1990, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE PREPARATION OF INTEGRATED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLANS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to revise Chapter 9, Revised Ordinance of Honolulu 1990, as amended, related to the submittal of integrated solid waste management plans, by amending the required submittal dates to conform to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") Section 342G-24.

HRS Section 342G-24, entitled "Submission schedule for revised integrated solid waste management plans," subsection (a) provides as follows:

- (a) Each state-approved county plan shall be revised and submitted to the office on the following schedule:
  - (1) The first revised plan shall be submitted to the office not later than four years after July 1, 1991; and
  - (2) Subsequent revised plans shall be submitted to the office once every ten years; provided that an interim status report on the implementation of a revised plan shall be submitted five years after every submission of a revised plan to the office.

SECTION 2. Section 9-1.13, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

**"Sec. 9-1.13 Preparation of integrated solid waste management plan.**

- (a) [By January 1, 2007, the] The department shall prepare and submit to the council, for its review, a revised [25-year] 10-year integrated solid waste management plan and interim status report that [meets] meet the requirements of Part III of HRS Chapter 342G. The department shall submit the revised plan to the state department of health and have it reviewed in accordance with HRS Section 342G-24.



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- (b) In addition to the contents of the integrated solid waste management plan required by HRS Section 342G-25, the county plan shall include [the following components:] an evaluation of alternative technologies that may be developed in the future to dispose of solid waste.
- [(1) The use of alternative technologies such as but not limited to plasma arc, gasification, vitrification or any other technologies that may be developed in the future to dispose of solid waste; and
- (2) The alternative of shipping the solid waste off-island to a regional solid waste disposal site.
- (c) By March 1, 2010, the department shall again revisit and revise the January 1, 2007 plan referred to in subsection (a) and submit the plan to the council. Every five years after 2010, the department shall make revisions to the plan and submit the revised plan to the council. The revised plan described herein shall also be submitted to the state department of health for review in accordance with HRS Section 342G-24.]"

SECTION 3. Ordinance material to be repealed is bracketed and new material is underscored. When revising, compiling, or printing this ordinance for inclusion in the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, the revisor of ordinances need not include the brackets, the bracketed materials, or the underscoring.



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SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
