



## RESOLUTION

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### EXPANDING THE USE OF ELECTRONIC SERVICES BY CITY DEPARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the use of credit and debit cards, electronic funds transfer, and digital wallets is a convenient and secure means of settling one's obligations for a wide variety of financial transactions, and for that reason is becoming more popular in conducting transactions involving government services and payments therefor; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-4.2 (a)(1) of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended ("ROH"), states that the Director of Budget and Fiscal Services ("Director") shall collect and receive moneys due to or receivable by the City and issue receipts therefor or authorize other executive agencies to do so under conditions prescribed by the Director; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-4.2 (b)(3) of the ROH states that the Director may accept payments of city taxes and other amounts owed to the City made by electronic means, which in the Director's discretion are determined acceptable to the City; and

WHEREAS, although the Department of Budget and Fiscal Services now accepts payments for real property tax assessments by electronic means, and the Department of Customer Services now accepts payments for motor vehicle registration by electronic means, there are many fees collected by various city departments that can currently only be paid using cash or check; and

WHEREAS, allowing additional fees to be paid by electronic means could potentially reduce the time required to process those payments by city employees as well as save time for both residents and businesses who would no longer need to travel to city facilities nor wait in line to pay those fees; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that the Director of the Department of Budget and Fiscal Services and the Director of the Department of Information Technology are requested to survey city departments to identify payments and other transactions which could be expedited through electronic means, and to assess the feasibility of implementation therefor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Budget and Fiscal Services and the Director of the Department of Information Technology report their findings to the City Council by September 1, 2013; and

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
