



RESOLUTION

RENAMING THE MANANA NEIGHBORHOOD PARK TO THE "SHIGEO USHIRO MANANA NEIGHBORHOOD PARK."

WHEREAS, subsections (e) and (f) of Section 22-9.5 of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended ("ROH"), state:

- (e) All naming or renaming of city parks, sites or facilities or any portion thereof shall be by resolution by the council of the City and County of Honolulu. Approval for the erection or placement of permanent memorials shall be by resolution, provided that an appropriate budget ordinance has been enacted where required.
- (f) The council may, on its own motion, designate a name for a new or existing park, site, facility, or any portion thereof, or memorial, consistent with the requirements set forth herein, by adoption of an appropriate resolution.

and

WHEREAS, additionally, Section 22-9.3(a)(3), ROH, states in part:

- (3) In exceptional cases, a new or existing park, site, facility or any portion thereof may be named for a person, or for a belief, ideal, concept or historical event of significance to the community, city, nation or world.
 - (A) In cases involving a deceased individual, that person shall meet one or more of the following criteria:
 - (i) The person has a significant association with the park, site, or facility;
 - (ii) The person has contributed significantly to the community or area in which the park, site or facility is located;
 - (iii) The person has achieved significant recognition historically on the city, state, national or international level; or
 - (iv) The person has been honored for service with the armed forces of the United States of America.

WHEREAS, the late Shigeo Ushiro was born on February 16, 1932, in Wailuku, Maui, and moved to the new Manana subdivision of Pearl City in 1968, where he became an active member and leader of the Pearl City community; and

WHEREAS, he was a 31-year career public school educator during which he was the Principal of Highlands Intermediate School in Pearl City from 1974 to 1986; and

WHEREAS, he was a long-time Board member of the Pearl City Community Association, which has the stated objective to promote the health and welfare of the entire Pearl City community, and during his tenure served in various leadership capacities, including President, and spearheaded the popular Goodwill/Scholarship Golf Tournament which raises money to fund scholarships to Pearl City High School students; and

WHEREAS, he co-founded and served as a Board member and treasurer of the Pearl City Foundation, a non-profit organization with the stated purpose to strengthen and enrich the Pearl City community as manifested through the multi-use Momilani Community Center which sponsors two major annual events and offers recreational programs throughout the year; and

WHEREAS, he was a founding member and first President of the Manana Community Association, a neighborhood organization that encourages fellowship and community participation, and during his tenure participated in the advocacy movement to build a swimming pool at the Manana Neighborhood Park; and

WHEREAS, due to his many years of outstanding and dedicated community service and interaction, he was a well known and highly respected member of the Pearl City community; and

WHEREAS, the Manana Neighborhood Park is a 4.02 acre park located at 1550 Kuahaka Street, Pearl City, Hawaii, with several facilities, including the swimming pool that he successfully championed for at this park; and

WHEREAS, upon his passing on June 18, 2010, renaming the Manana Neighborhood Park is an appropriate way to honor his lifetime of compassionate and committed service to not only his Manana neighborhood, but also the greater Pearl City community; now, therefore,



RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that the Manana Neighborhood Park be renamed the "Shigeo Ushiro Manana Neighborhood Park"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council requests the City administration to erect appropriate signage and approves the placement of such signage at the park; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Director of Parks and Recreation and the family of the late Shigeo Ushiro.




