Mr. Chair:

Your Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Human Services, which considered Resolution 13-194 entitled:

"RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE INCLUSION IN THE 2014 HAWAII STATE ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES ("HSAC") LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE A PROPOSAL THAT PROVIDES FLEXIBLE DESIGN GUIDELINES FOR SIDEWALKS,"

introduced on August 14, 2013, reports as follows:

The purpose of the Resolution is to include in the 2014 Hawaii State Association of Counties (HSAC) legislative package a proposal that provides flexible design guidelines for sidewalks.

The Director of the Department of Transportation Services (DTS) expressed concerns with the Resolution noting federal and state laws regarding accessibility requirements for sidewalks under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Your Committee shared the concerns but because of time constraints would move the Resolution forward and work with the DTS and obtain legal advice to ensure that the measure does not violate ADA requirements.

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
