

Transmitted herewith for your approval is a summary report in accordance with Resolution 13-260, CD1, to ensure a safe and secure 2013 Honolulu Marathon Event.


Three (3) new video camera locations at Ala Moana Boulevard/Queen Street, Nimitz Highway/Nuuanu Avenue, and Kapiolani Boulevard/Piikoi Street have been retained by the Department of Transportation Services for traffic management purposes. The remaining ten (10) new video camera locations have been deactivated and all cameras removed. The video cameras that were removed are being retained by the Department of Transportation Services and will be repurposed/refurbished for use for future City-sponsored or co-sponsored events that may require additional cameras for increased security or traffic management. All other existing traffic cameras listed for use in monitoring the 2013 Honolulu Marathon are now being used for traffic management purposes. All event video recordings have been destroyed by the Department of Transportation Services (see Enclosure 1). All video notification signs have been removed by the Department of Facility Maintenance (see Enclosure 2).


