Mr. Chair:

Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred Resolution 13-285, entitled:

“APPROVING NEW CITY INVOLVED WORK ELEMENTS FOR INCLUSION IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 OVERALL WORK PROGRAM”

transmitted by Communication D-865, dated November 15, 2013, from the Department of Transportation Services reports as follows:

This Resolution approves the addition of a new work element, the Complete Streets Implementation Study, in the FY-2014 Overall Work Program (OWP). The OWP is prepared annually by the Oahu Metropolitan Planning Organization in cooperation with its participating agencies and describes all planning activities to be performed with federal highway or transit funds.

The lead agency for this study will be the City's Department of Transportation Services (DTS). The scope and framework for the study calls for establishing a baseline and benchmarks for measuring the City's Complete Streets progress, assessing roadblocks to implementation, developing an implementation plan, and facilitating interdepartmental coordination. The total cost of the study is \$500,000 (\$400,000 in federal funds and \$100,000 in local matching funds).
