



RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND PERMITTING INVESTIGATE THE HAWAII KAI MEMORIAL PARK.

WHEREAS, Resolution 00-260, adopted by the Council on January 24, 2001 approved the location and boundaries of a cemetery in Hawaii Kai, tax map key 3-9-19:44, today known as Hawaii Kai Memorial Park; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 00-260 required the Applicant to prepare a geotechnical study and to implement recommendations of the study, and to further prepare a traffic impact analysis report for the project, prior to approval by the Department of Planning and Permitting (DPP) of any subdivision, grading permits, or building permits; and

WHEREAS, more than ten years after adoption of Resolution 00-260, the cemetery has not been completed and the Hawaii Kai Neighborhood Board has raised concerns that stockpiling at the cemetery site is not being conducted in accordance with recommendations of geotechnical reports that were prepared for the property; and

WHEREAS, the Council has concerns that stockpiling at the cemetery site may endanger neighboring properties and impair water quality at Kuapa Pond; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that the Department of Planning and Permitting is requested to conduct an investigation of Hawaii Kai Memorial Park and report back to the Council on the following:

1. The number of grading, grubbing, and stockpiling permits issued for the cemetery since the adoption of Resolution 00-260, and any extensions or renewals thereof.
2. Any violations of the permits and whether corrective actions have been taken.
3. The conditions imposed by the DPP on the stockpiling to prevent nuisance or hazard, and whether the DPP is contemplating additional conditions.
4. The extent of DPP monitoring of the stockpiling operations to date, and the extent of its monitoring in the future.
5. Whether the existing conditions at the site and the cemetery owner's noncompliance with permit conditions and applicable law are sufficient to justify the DPP to refuse to extend or renew existing stockpiling permits, suspend or revoke any existing permits, or deny any future permits.




