



A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

RELATING TO THE MINIMUM REAL PROPERTY TAX.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the minimum real property tax.

SECTION 2. Section 8-11.1, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 ("Real property tax—Determination of rates"), is amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:

"(g) Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, there shall be levied upon each individual parcel of real property taxable under this chapter a minimum real property tax [of \$300.00 a year, except for properties exempt under Section 8-10.27 and except as provided in Section 8-10.28(b)(2).] as follows:

(1) All real property, except for those exempt under Section 8-10.10 or Section 8-10.27 and except as provided in Section 8-10.28(b)(2), shall be levied a minimum real property tax of \$300.00.

(2) All real property granted an exemption under Section 8-10.10 shall be levied a minimum real property tax in accordance with the following schedule:

For the tax year beginning July 1, 2014: \$.

For the tax year beginning July 1, 2015: \$.

For the tax year beginning July 1, 2016: \$.

For the tax year beginning July 1, 2017: \$.

For the tax year beginning July 1, 2018: \$.

For the tax year beginning July 1, 2019 and thereafter: \$. "

SECTION 3. Ordinance material to be repealed is bracketed. New ordinance material is underscored. When revising, compiling or printing this ordinance for inclusion in the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, the revisor of ordinances need not include the brackets, bracketed material, or the underscoring.
