Your Committee on Parks and Customer Services, to which was referred Resolution 14-101 entitled:

"RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT TO THE CITY FROM THE FAMILY OF CLARA JOYCE PUANANI OLDS,"

introduced on May 13, 2014, reports as follows:

The purpose of this Resolution is to accept a gift of funds in the amount of \$3,007.00 from the family of Clara Joyce Puanani Olds to be used to purchase a standard recycled park bench measuring five feet with back, and to pay for the costs of ground preparation, building of forms, and pouring of concrete to form a six feet by four feet pad for the bench to be placed on and installed at Kailua Beach Park. A plaque with an inscription to read, "Donated by the Family of Clara Joyce Puanani Olds" will be attached to the bench.

The Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation testified in support of the Resolution and requested Council's favorable consideration.

No public testimony was presented or received on this Resolution.
