Mr. Chair:

Your Committee on Public Works and Sustainability, to which was referred Departmental Communication 414, hereinafter Dept. Com. 414, regarding:

"DOCUMENTS CONVEYING ROADWAYS AND EASEMENTS FOR PUBLIC USE IN EWA,"

from the Department of Design and Construction, dated May 20, 2014, reports as follows:

The purpose of Dept. Com. 414 is to request that the Council approve the grants conveying Drain Easements 8677, 8678, 8679, 8681, 8682, 8683, 8685, and 8733; Flowage Easements 8677, 8681, 8682, 8685, 8686, 8687, 8690, and 8733; Access Easement 8696; and Sewer Easements 8692 and 8695 for public use in Ewa.

Dept. Com. 414 attests that roadway lot 16395, proposed to be dedicated to the City, have been laid out, improved and approved in conformity with ROH Section 22-3.9 and the subdivision regulations. Accordingly, pursuant to Ordinance 10-20, the roadway shall be deemed accepted for dedication by the City Council, without further action by the Council, 30 days from the receipt of Dept. Com. 414.


Ordinance 10-20 (Relating to the Acceptance of Streets and Roadways) does not apply to the grants of the aforesaid drain easements, flowage easements, access easement, and sewer easements, and therefore as to those easements, the Council is being asked to approve and accept the easements.

A representative from the Department of Design and Construction testified in support of approving the easements, noting that all associated improvements have been constructed, completed and certified as meeting City requirements at no cost to the City.

No public testimony was presented or received on this Resolution..

Your Committee on Public Works and Sustainability is in accord with the intent and purpose of Dept. Com. 414 and recommends that: (1) said grants conveying drain easements, flowage easements, access easement, and sewer easements be approved and accepted by the Council effective as of the date of recordation at the Bureau of Conveyances, (2) the Mayor be authorized to execute the documents on behalf of the City, and that (3) upon completion, all dedication and grant documents be forwarded to the Land Division of the Department of Design and Construction for further processing.
