Mr. Chair:

Your Committee on Zoning and Planning, to which was referred Bill 46 (2014) entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO URINATING AND DEFECATING IN PUBLIC,"

which passed First Reading at the June 26, 2014 Council meeting, reports as follows:

The purpose of Bill 46 (2014) is to prohibit intentionally or knowingly urinating or defecating in a public place, or in any area where such an act is likely to be observed by any member of the public. The Bill does not apply to persons who failed to use a restroom or toilet facility due to a medical condition verified by a licensed physician; persons urinating or defecating while using appropriate fixtures in any restroom or toilet facility designed for sanitary disposal of human waste; or where urination or defecation is already prohibited by State law.

At your Committee's meeting on June 26, 2014, your Committee considered Bill 42 (2014), Bill 43 (2014), Bill 45 (2014), and Bill 46 (2014) together. Your Committee received testimony in support from one member of the public. Testimony in opposition was received from three individuals and The Pacific Alliance to Stop Slavery. Comments were received from 10 individuals.


