1. **RESOLUTION 15-36 – ACCEPTANCE OF GIFT FROM FIRST HAWAIIAN BANK.** Accepting a gift to cover equipment rental fees valued at \$11,000.00 and in-kind gifts valued at \$10,000.00 from the First Hawaiian Bank for the 2015 PrimeTime Wellness Fair to be held on March 5, 2015 at the Neal Blaisdell Center Exhibition Hall. 2. **RESOLUTION 15-37 – ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT FROM THE FAMILY OF DONALD “BIRDSNEST” TAKAYAMA.** Accepting a gift valued at \$2,998.75 to purchase a standard park bench and to pay for the cost of ground preparation, building forms, and pouring of concrete pad for the bench at Aina Moana Beach Park. 3. **RESOLUTION 15-38 – ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT FROM INSITUFORM TECHNOLOGIES, LLC.** Accepting a gift valued at \$3,000.00 from Insituform Technologies, LLC for the maintenance and upkeep of Wailupe Beach Park. (Transmitted by Communication [D-74](#))
4. **BILL 58 (2014), CD1 – RELATING TO PARKS.** Establishing an Adopt-a-Park program. (Bill 58, CD1 passed second reading and public hearing held 2/18/15)
5. **BILL 8 (2015) – COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES AT PUBLIC PARKS.** Addressing commercial activities at certain City beach parks. (Bill 8 passed first reading 2/18/15)
6. **BILL 9 (2015) – RELATING TO PARKS.** Prohibiting persons convicted of promoting or trafficking in a drug or intoxicating compound under Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 712, Part IV, from entering public parks. (Bill 9 passed first reading 2/18/15)

7. [BILL 84 \(2014\)](#) – **EXCEPTIONAL TREES**. Amending the register of exceptional trees and clarifying the powers, duties, and procedures of the arborist advisory committee. (Transmitted by Communication [D-838](#); Bill 84 passed first reading 1/28/15)

[PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 84 \(2014\)](#) (Submitted by Councilmember Pine) – The CD1 (OCS/020915/10:31/CT) makes the following amendments:

- A. Clarifies that the purpose of the measure is to:
  - a. Amend the register of exceptional trees; and
  - b. Clarify the powers, duties, and procedures of the Director of Parks and Recreation and the Arborist Advisory Committee.
- B. Adds the lead language from Section 41-13.7, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 ("ROH").
- C. Converts the listing of trees in each subsection of Section 41-13.7, ROH, into a table format and:
  - a. Adds the following table headers:
    - i. "Name of Tree and/or Scientific Name;"
    - ii. "Description of Location (if available);" and
    - iii. "TMK (if available);" and
  - b. Groups multiple trees of the same species under one listing in the first column for consistency and clarity.
- D. Directs the Revisor of Ordinances to merge cells in the first column of the table that refer to the same tree species. References to the species after the initial reference are deleted.
- E. Conforms the ramseyering throughout the measure to current drafting conventions.
- F. Makes miscellaneous technical and non-substantive amendments for purposes of clarity, consistency and style.
