RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE NOMINATION OF GARY K. NAKATA TO SERVE AS THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNITY SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

WHEREAS, Section 4-104.1 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu 1973 (2000 Edition), as amended ("RCH"), requires that all department heads and the Managing Director, nominated by the Mayor, be subject to the advice and consent of the Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-301, RCH, establishes the Department of Community Services, to include a Director of Community Services; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-302, RCH, states that the Director of Community Services shall:

- (1) Develop and administer projects, programs and plans of action for human resources, human services and housing programs;
- (2) Develop and administer projects, programs and plans of action designed to achieve sound community development, provided that such projects, programs and plans of action conform to and implement the general plan and development plans;
- (3) Administer grants awarded from the grants in aid fund; and
- (4) Act as the local public officer for the purpose of implementing federally-aided and state-aided human resources, human services, housing, urban renewal and community development programs;

and

WHEREAS, Section 4-104.1, RCH, requires that each department head be a registered voter of the City and County of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, via Mayor's Message _____ dated _____ the Mayor has nominated Gary K. Nakata to serve as Director of Community Services; and

WHEREAS, after review of the nominee's qualifications, the Council finds that Mr. Nakata is qualified to serve as Director of Community Services and warrants confirmation; now, therefore,
