A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

---

RELATING TO THE HANAUMA BAY NATURE PRESERVE FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to require that the interest earned on deposits into the Hanauma Bay Nature Preserve Fund be deposited in the Fund.

SECTION 2. Section 6-51.2, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

**"Sec. 6-51.2 Purpose[.] and Deposits.**

There [shall] will be deposited into the Hanauma Bay Nature Preserve fund all receipts from the fees imposed under Section 10-2.11 and all concession revenues from the Hanauma Bay Nature Preserve concessions[.], plus any interest earned on deposits in the fund. All moneys deposited into this fund [shall] will be used for the following purposes in the order of priority as indicated:

- (1) First, for the operation, maintenance and improvement of the Hanauma Bay Nature Preserve;
- (2) Second, for educational and orientation programs for visitors to the preserve; and
- (3) Third, for a carrying capacity study of the preserve and for other studies relating to the environmental condition of the preserve."

SECTION 3. Ordinance material to be repealed is bracketed. New ordinance material is underscored. When revising, compiling or printing this ordinance for inclusion in the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, the revisor of ordinances need not include the underscoring, the brackets or the bracketed material.

SECTION 4. This ordinance takes effect upon its approval and interest earned on deposits in the fund from the effective date will be credited to the fund.


