Accept Terms and Conditions (*) 1

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THIS IS FOR BILL 13 CONCERNING FUNDING FOR THE REPAIRS FOR FRONT LOADED REFUSE TRUCKS THAT PRESENTLY PICK UP FROM 181 CONDOMINIUMS.

THERE HAS BEEN NO MONEY SET ASIDE FOR THE REPAIRS OF THE REFUSE TRUCK AND DUE TO THE PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND VIOLATION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL MERITS UNDER ARTICLE XVI, SECTION 1 OF HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION AND A VIOLATION OF CIVIL SERVICE LAWS WITH THE UNION REGARDING THE UNLAWFUL PRIVITIZATION OF REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES HISTORICALLY AND CUSTOMERILY PROVIDED BY REFUSE COLLECTION CREW LEADERS AND REFUSE COLLECTORS ON FRONT END LOADER WORK CREWS ON OAHU TO 181 MULTI-FAMILY PROPERTIES, CONDOMINIUMS AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS. THE PLAN OF PRIVATIZATION DUE TO THE AGE OF THE FRONT LOAD TRUCKS WAS THOUGHT A SOLUTION FOR RETIRING CERTAIN FRONT LOADER TRUCKS. THAT IS NO LONGER POSSIBLE GIVEN THE SUMMARY JUDGEMENT APPROVED BY THE JUDGE SAKAMOTO ON 2/20/2015.

BECAUSE OF THIS JUDGEMENT I ASK THAT MONEY FROM THE BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.-\$10,000. DOLLARS SHOULD BE SET ASIDE TO KEEP THE FRONT LOADING TRUCKS WORKING AND NOT FALL INTO DISREPAIR.

PLUS THIS BILL IS TO START ON THE SAME DAY THAT CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 9 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU CONCERNING THE BANNING OF PLASTIC BAGS. THERE IS ALWAYS, PUBLIC CONFUSION OVER THE TRANSITION TO THE NEW LAW SO LOOSE GARBAGE MAY BE IN THOSE BINS!

IF MONEY IS NOT SET ASIDE THE CONSEQUENCES COULD BE DIRE:

1. GARBAGE WILL BE LEFT ON THE STREET
2. BINS WILL BE LEFT ON THE STREET BLOCKING TRAFFIC AS NO CONDO WILL WANT THE BINS ON PROPERTY.
3. BINS WILL SMELL REALLY BADLY AFFECTING AIR QUALITY
4. BUGS, RODENTS AND THE HOMELESS MIGHT DIG THROUGH THE TRASH BINS
5. IT WILL BE TERRIBLY UNSIGHTLY AND ENVIRONMENTALLY HANDICAPPED
6. THE INFECTED AIR MIGHT CAUSE MAJOR HEALTH ISSUES
7. WASTE MANAGEMENT WILL BE DIFFICULT TO MAINTAIN SO LIQUIDS MIGHT FALL INTO WATER SYSTEMS

FOR ALL THESE REASONS IT WOULD BE WISE TO SET ASIDE MONIES FOR REPAIRS ON ANY AND ALL FRONT LOADER REFUSE TRUCKS.
