MINUTES OF THE JULY 23, 2015 REGULAR MEETING

FOR ACTION

1. **Bill 59 (2015) – RELATING TO COMPLETE STREETS.** The purpose of the ordinance is to amend the Traffic Code of the City and County of Honolulu, as set forth in Chapter 15 of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, as amended, to enable the City to implement Complete Streets features. [Bill 59 (2015) passed first reading on 8/5/15]

2. **Bill 60 (2015) – RELATING TO PARADES.** The purpose of the ordinance is to amend the Traffic Code of the City and County of Honolulu, as set forth in Chapter 15 of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, 1990, as amended, to enable the City to equitably regulate legacy parades and activities in the Waikiki special district. [Bill 60 (2015) passed first reading on 8/5/15. Transmitted by **Communication D-566**]

3. **BILL 52 (2015) – RESTRICTED PARKING ZONES.** The purpose of the bill is to establish a restricted parking zone (RPZ) program to help ease parking congestion in residential neighborhoods surrounded by major traffic generators like hospitals and universities, while balancing the needs of all people to use the public streets. [Bill 52 (2015) passed second reading and public hearing held on 8/5/15]

PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 52 (2015) – (Submitted by Councilmember Fukunaga)
– The CD1 (OCS2015-0762/8/10/2015 12:15 PM) makes the following amendments:

1. Adds Sec.15-_.4(a) which restricts the establishment of an RPZ to the neighborhoods from Kaimuki-Kapahulu-Waikiki and extending to Salt Lake-Moanalua-Kalihi Valley, with special consideration to those neighborhoods adjacent to large traffic generators such as health care institutions, schools or universities.

2. Amends Sec.15-_.4(c) to clarify that the director may establish or expand an RPZ when 75 percent or more of the capacity of the streets available for parking on four contiguous blocks (or ___ on-street parking stalls) are generally occupied.
