MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE ON ZONING AND PLANNING  
OCTOBER 19, 2015 REGULAR AND NOVEMBER 2, 2015 SPECIAL MEETINGS

**FOR ACTION**

1. **BILL 8 (2015) – COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES AT PUBLIC PARKS.** Addressing commercial activities at certain City beach parks. (Bill 8 passed second reading and public hearing held 6/3/15; re-referred to Zoning and Planning 11/5/15)

PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 8 (2015) (Submitted by Councilmember Anderson) – The CD1 (OCS2015-1131/11/13/2015 1:16 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Further amends the definition of "commercial activity" in Section 10-1.1(h), Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 ("ROH"), by specifying that the use of premises and facilities at Waimanalo Bay Beach Park and Waimanalo Beach Park for youth sports for students ages pre-school through high school and educational events, for students ages pre-school through high school, conducted or offered by educational institutions recognized by the State of Hawaii Department of Education, will also not be "commercial activities."
- B. Adds a definition of "director" to mean the director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, or the director's designated representative.
- C. Further amends Section 10-1.2(h), ROH, to provide that commercial activities, including recreational stops by tour companies, are not allowed at:
  - (1) Waimanalo Bay Beach Park from 6:30 p.m. on Fridays through 6:30 a.m. on Mondays rather than at any time; and
  - (2) Bellows Field Beach Park from 6:30 p.m. on Fridays through 6:30 a.m. on Mondays.
- D. Revises the permit provision of Section 10-1.3(a)(11) to include commercial activity prohibitions at Waimanalo Beach Park, Kaiona Beach Park, Kaupo Beach Park, Makapuu Beach Park, Waimanalo Bay Beach Park and Bellows Field Beach Park.

- E. Further amends Section 10-3.2(c), ROH:
  - (1) By deleting references to Waimanalo Beach Park, Kaiona Beach Park, Kaupo Beach Park and Makapuu Beach Park;
  - (2) By providing that, notwithstanding Section 10-1.2, commercial filming activities may take place at Bellows Field Beach Park and Waimanalo Bay Beach Park from 6:30 a.m. on Mondays through 6:30 p.m. on Fridays; provided that if a state or federal holiday falls on a Friday, commercial filming activities may only take place from midnight to 6:30 a.m. on that Friday; and provided further that if a state or federal holiday falls on a Monday, commercial filming activities may not take place at any time on that Monday and until 6:30 a.m. on the following Tuesday; and
  - (3) By further providing that for commercial filming activities in the parks listed in this subsection, all permit requirements must be satisfied and that the public must not be unduly inconvenienced nor be deprived of the use of any park or beach during commercial filming activities.
- F. Makes miscellaneous technical and non-substantive amendments.

- 2. **BILL 68 (2015) – PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE MAPS.** Adding bikeways as a type of public infrastructure to be shown on public infrastructure maps. (Bill 68 passed second reading and public hearing held 11/4/15)

PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 68 (2015) (Submitted by Councilmember Fukunaga) – The CD1 (OCS2015-1132/11/13/2015 2:28 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Amends proposed subdivision 4-8.3(a)(18) to limit the bikeways that will have to be shown on the Public Infrastructure Maps to those on or along a major collector or arterial roadway. (Major projects on major collector or arterial roadways are currently required to be shown on the PIMs under subdivision 4-8.3 (a)(15)).
