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**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE**

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RELATING TO CULTURAL SITES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a program within the department of parks and recreation for the designation of sites of cultural value located in city public parks.

SECTION 2. Chapter 10, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 ("Rules, Regulations, Charges and Fees for Public Parks and Recreation Facilities"), is amended by adding a new article to be appropriately designated by the revisor of ordinances and to read as follows:

**"Article \_\_. Cultural Sites in Public Parks**

**Sec. 10-\_\_1 Definitions.**

For purposes of this article, the following term applies:

"Cultural site" means any building, structure, object, area, or site which is:  
1) deemed significant to the history, architecture, archaeology, or culture of the city and its communities; 2) included in a city development plan; or 3) recommended by a neighborhood board.

**Sec. 10-\_\_2 Cultural Sites in Public Parks Program.**

- (a) The department may establish a program for the designation of cultural sites located in public parks in accordance with the following:
  - (1) Any interested person may recommend the designation of a cultural site to the department.
  - (2) When a cultural site is recommended by the department to be designated in a public park, the director shall submit the recommendation to the council in the form of a draft resolution for approval.



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- (3) The director's recommendation and draft resolution must include the following:
  - (A) The name and address of the public park where the proposed cultural site is located;
  - (B) A description of the approximate location where the proposed cultural site will be located within the public park;
  - (C) A name and brief physical description of the proposed cultural site;
  - (D) A brief description of the cultural impact of the site on the city or surrounding communities; and
  - (E) Detailed information, such as size, shape, type of materials, any maintenance costs, and total costs of the marker sign.
- (b) The council may, at its discretion, designate a cultural site by adoption of a resolution that includes the same information as is required of the department in subsection (a), except information relating to costs.
- (c) All designations of cultural sites, whether initiated by the director or by the council, must be by resolution by the council.
- (d) Upon adoption of an appropriate resolution by the council, it is a duty of the department to erect, install, or place a sign informing the public of the designated cultural site. The sign must be consistent with terms of the resolution."
