- **RESOLUTION 15-282** -- RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO CONSIDER THE USE OF AMBU-BUSES TO PROVIDE MOBILE HEALTH SERVICES TO THE HOMELESS.
- **RESOLUTION 15-295** -- RESOLUTION URGING THE ADMINISTRATION TO IMMEDIATELY FUND AND IMPLEMENT SERVICES AND PERMANENT HOUSING SOLUTIONS FOR HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES
- **RESOLUTION 16-62** -- REQUESTING THE CITY TO WORK WITH THE STATE TO ESTABLISH A COLLABORATIVE FUNDING PROCESS BY WHICH
