Bill 13 (2016) is one more violation of our citizens rights of Freedom of Religion. Honolulu must not misuse our taxpayers dollars to pay for anymore expenses for churches that already skip their expenses for Waste Management which is the cost of their operations, not the responsibilities of our taxpayers! Bill 13 (2016) Grant in Aid of \$250,000 to New Hop'te Church to build a parking garage is a violation of the United States Constitution's Separation of State and Church. New Hope Chapel needs to step up to the plate and begin paying for the Social Services such as Fire Fighters, police and other services that they benefit from yet don't share in the cost that the taxpayer pays for!!!
