Dear Chair Martin and City Council Members, I SUPPORT the funding for Kānewai Spring through the unamended version of Bill 15. Therefore, I STRONGLY OPPOSE the suggested amendment to Bill 15 to delete the funding under the proposed draft FD1 by Councilman Ozawa. Public water belongs to the public. We cannot allow it to be privatized. Developers must not be allowed to take this precious resource from the community. I ask all of you to support the community's rights to access to this water. You need to keep the Clean Water funding in the budget for Kānewai Spring. Kānewai Spring provides water for many fish and wildlife. It feeds Kānewai Fishpond, Paikō Wildlife Sanctuary and Maunaloa Bay. It is also a cultural and historic site. The City Clean Water and Natural Lands Commission has strongly recommended funding to purchase and preserve Kānewai Spring. This is what the City Council should do – protect this

resource for present and future generations from developers.
