Aloha my name is Austin Kino and I support the funding for Kānewai Spring and oppose the suggested amendment to delete the funding under the proposed draft FD1 by Councilman Ozawa. I am a crew member of the Hōkūle'a and a life long resident of Maunalua Bay. In response to the current world wide voyage that is taking place, a friend and I started an environmental education LLC for Maunalua Bay schools and the program is called the Maunalua Junior Konohiki Program. This program takes students paddling in canoes to collect and analyze plankton samples, within paiko sanctuary the students remove invasive plants and plant native trees, and lastly the students walk around the sanctuary to collect and perform water quality sampling.

Written Testimony In the future our organization hopes to partner with Maunalua Fishpond Heritage Center on future education programs that would use Kalauha'iha'i and Kanewai Spring as an educational resource. If the fresh water spring was no longer being cared for and sold to private entities then our students in Maunalua would have no reference as to what a healthy ahupua'a ecosystem looks like. Although we are a new program, we have received lots of support from our community and plan on continuing our work long into the future as our contribution to return Maunalua Bay to a healthy eco-system, which requires the fresh water provided by Kanewai and Kalauha'iha'i.
