WHEREAS, through a letter, the Director of the Honolulu Emergency Services Department (hereinafter HESD) has submitted a request to the Council that was approved by the Managing Director for the acceptance of gift valued at \$3,148.00 from CeraVe, that includes CeraVe Face Sunscreen and CeraVe Body Sunscreen for use by the Ocean Safety lifeguard personnel; and




