Your Committee on Public Health, Safety and Welfare, which considered Resolution 16-154 entitled:

“RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT TO THE CITY FROM CERAVE SUNSCREEN AND SKIN CARE FOR THE HONOLULU EMERGENCY SERVICES DEPARTMENT, OCEAN SAFETY AND LIFEGUARD SERVICES DIVISION,”

transmitted by Departmental Communication No. 396, dated June 1, 2016, from the Honolulu Emergency Services Department and introduced on June 8, 2016, reports as follows:

The purpose of the Resolution is to accept a gift valued at \$3,148 from CeraVe Sunscreen and Skin Care consisting of CeraVe Face Sunscreen and CeraVe Body Sunscreen for use by the Ocean Safety lifeguard personnel of the Honolulu Emergency Services Department, Ocean Safety and Lifeguard Services Division.

The Deputy Director and an Ocean Safety Officer of the Honolulu Emergency Services Department testified in support of this gift.

COMMITTEE REPORT NO. **221**

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Section 13-113 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu 1973, as amended, provides as follows:

Your Committee finds that the acceptance of this gift conforms with the applicable provisions of Resolution 05-349, CD1, FD1, and that this gift will benefit the people of the City and County of Honolulu.
