



**RESOLUTION**

RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF ANN E. ASAKURA TO SERVE ON THE COMMISSION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

WHEREAS, Chapter 3, Article 2, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 (ROH), establishes the Commission on Culture and the Arts to assist the city in attaining national preeminence in culture and the arts, to assist the city in the preservation of the artistic and cultural heritages of all its people, to promote a community environment which provides equal and abundant opportunity for exposure to culture and the arts in all its forms and to encourage and provide equal opportunity for the development of cultural and artistic talents of the people of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is comprised of 11 members appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the council to five-year terms, and six ex officio, nonvoting members; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-2.2, ROH, requires ten of the appointed members to represent a particular cultural or artistic category and one appointed member as an at-large representative; and

WHEREAS, by Mayor's Letter, dated July 20, 2016, the Mayor has appointed Ann E. Asakura to serve on the Commission as the representative of the crafts category; and

WHEREAS, if confirmed by the council, Ms. Asakura will replace Paulette N. Kahalepuna whose term expired on June 30, 2016, and will serve for a term which expires on June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-103 of the Revised Charter of Honolulu 1973, as amended, includes a general qualification requiring each member of a city board or commission to be a registered voter of the city; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the qualifications and character of Ms. Asakura and finds that she is qualified to serve on the Commission and deserves confirmation; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that it confirms the appointment of Ann E. Asakura to serve on the Commission on Culture and the Arts as the representative of the crafts category for a term expiring on June 30, 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Ms. Asakura for her willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in city government; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Chair of the Commission on Culture and the Arts, and Ann E. Asakura.


