

## RESOLUTION

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RELATING TO THE REAPPOINTMENT OF JOSEPH O'DONNELL TO SERVE ON THE LIQUOR COMMISSION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

WHEREAS, Section 281-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS"), as amended, establishes a liquor commission for each county consisting of at least five members appointed by the county mayor and confirmed by the county council to five-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the major duties of the Honolulu Liquor Commission are the following: 1) granting and, if necessary, suspending or revoking liquor licenses; 2) monitoring the operations of liquor licensees; 3) adopting rules on the proper conduct of liquor manufacturers, importers, and sellers; and 4) enforcing state laws and commission rules relating to liquor; and

WHEREAS, Section 281-11, HRS, establishes the following qualifications and disqualifications applicable to the Honolulu Liquor Commission member:

- (1) A member must be a United States citizen;
- (2) A member must have resided in the county served by the commission for at least three years immediately preceding appointment;
- (3) A member cannot engage or hold a direct or indirect interest in "any business for the manufacture or sale of liquor";
- (4) A member cannot be an advocate or member of or identified or connected with "any organization or association which advocates prohibition";
- (5) A member cannot be an elected state or county officer or a candidate for a public office while on the commission; and
- (6) A member cannot belong to same political party to which a quorum of other members already belong;

and

WHEREAS, by Mayor's Message, dated August 24, 2016, the Mayor has reappointed Joseph O'Donnell to the Honolulu Liquor Commission; and

WHEREAS, if confirmed by the Council, Mr. O'Donnell, whose first full term expired on December 31, 2016, will serve for a second full term that will expire on December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, based on its review of the appointee, the Council finds that Mr. O'Donnell qualifies to serve on the Honolulu Liquor Commission and deserves confirmation; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City and County of Honolulu that this body confirms the reappointment of Joseph O'Donnell to the Honolulu Liquor Commission to serve for a second term expiring on December 31, 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Mr. O'Donnell for his willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in city government; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the chair of the Honolulu Liquor Commission and Joseph O'Donnell.
