Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred
Resolution 16-212:

"URGING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO REPLACE ALL CITY-OPERATED
COIN ONLY PARKING METERS WITH SMART PARKING METERS,"

introduced on August 16, 2016, reports as follows:

The purpose of this Resolution is to urge the City Administration to replace all city-operated coin-only parking meters with smart parking meters."

Department of Transportation Services ("DTS") Acting Director Mark Garrity testified in support of the Resolution, reporting that there are other cities, such as Seattle, that are good examples of jurisdictions that have successfully managed their parking resources. Noting that the latest technology will read and accept "chip" credit cards, he stated that by the end of the year, the City will have converted about 1,050 out of its 4,000 meters to these type of smart parking meters. Two individuals offered comments.


