Your Committee on Public Health, Safety and Welfare, which considered Resolution 16-233 entitled:

“RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT TO THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU FROM THE DEPUTIES FOR THE HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT’S LAW ENFORCEMENT EXPLORER PROGRAM,”

COMMITTEE REPORT NO. **284**

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Section 13-113 of the Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu 1973, as amended, provides as follows:

The council, on behalf of the city, may accept gifts or donations of money, securities or other personal property or of real estate or any interest in real estate.

To implement this Charter provision, the Council adopted Resolution 05-349, CD1, FD1, which establishes guidelines for the solicitation and receipt of gifts on behalf of the City.

Your Committee finds that the acceptance of this gift conforms with the applicable provisions of Resolution 05-349, CD1, FD1, and that this gift will benefit the people of the City and County of Honolulu.
