Mr. Chair:

Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred Resolution 16-209:

"URGING THE HAWAII STATE LEGISLATURE TO ENACT LEGISLATION TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN BEHAVIORS INCITED BY OR LIKELY TO INCITE ROAD RAGE,"

introduced on August 16, 2016, reports as follows:

The purpose of the Resolution is to urge the Hawaii State Legislature to enact legislation to prohibit certain behaviors incited by or likely to incite road rage.

Honolulu Police Department ("HPD") Major Kerry Inouye testified in support of measures that increase traffic safety and awareness of hazardous driving, but noted HPD concerns regarding the determination of driver intent and other enforcement issues. Major Inouye further noted that HPD is researching other U.S. jurisdictions that may have successfully addressed verifiable aggressive driving, such as speeding combined with un signaled lane changes, through the use of enhanced penalties. One individual offered comments.


