THIS ADDENDUM ITEM IS A PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 55 (2016) AGENDA ITEM NO. 22):

FOR ACTION

1. **PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 55 (2016) – PRIVATE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AND DRIVERS.** Amending Ordinance 16-25, relating to private transportation services and drivers. (Submitted by Councilmember Kobayashi) The proposed CD1 (OCS2016-1119/11/14/2016 10:57) makes the following amendments:
 - A. Amends the article established by Ordinance 16-25 to make various changes to ensure the health and safety of passengers of private transportation vehicles.
 - B. Allows a 60-day grace period starting on January 15, 2016 to allow private transportation companies and drivers time to comply with the new requirements. During this period, the department will be able to issue and renew taxicab driver certificates which will expire upon the end of the 60-day grace period.
 - C. States that the director may establish fees.
 - D. Requires that the department certify a driver if the driver and the private transportation company are one and the same person.
 - E. Designates that the effective date of the Bill, for most of the provisions, is January 15, 2017.
 - F. Makes miscellaneous technical and non-substantive amendments.
