I believe such development would have a negative impact on the Health, Safety and wellbeing of the Residents of and visitors of the area alike. I live in Kaaawa in Kaaawa Park Lane and at rush hour in the mornings between 5:30 am and 8:30 am and rush hour in the evenings between 2:30 pm and 6:30 pm it is not only frustrating but also very dangerous to enter the flow or cross lanes to go in the flow of traffic towards the North Shore. Trucks hauling fill from the tunnel being bored from Kaneohe to Kailua for the expansion of the wastewater tunnel along with the increasing number of tour busses from Honolulu to the Polynesian Cultural Center in Laie has made travel on Kamehameha Highway very dangerous at most times of the day. Road expansion and improvement are needed just to cover the traffic we have now.
