1. **BILL 59 (2016), CD1 – RELATING TO THE USE OF BAGS PROVIDED TO CUSTOMERS.** Regulating the use of bags provided to customers. (Bill 59, CD1 passed second reading and public hearing held on 3/22/17)

**PROPOSED CD2 TO BILL 59 (2016), CD1** (Submitted by Councilmember Fukunaga) – The CD2 (OCS2017-0447/4/25/2017 2:10 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Section 1 of the Bill is amended to add findings regarding the Council's intent concerning the amendments in the Bill.
  - B. The definitions for "Compostable plastic bag" and "Reusable bag" are deleted and the definition for "Plastic checkout bag" is amended.
  - C. Section 9-9.2 is amended to prohibit businesses from providing plastic checkout bags and non-recyclable paper bags unless the business charges a fee of not less than ten cents per bag. Businesses may provide bags, with or without charge, to protect or transport prepared foods, beverages, or bakery goods.
  - D. The effective date of the Bill is changed from July 1, 2017 to July 1, 2018.
  - E. Makes technical and nonsubstantive changes.
2. **BILL 43 (2016) – RELATING TO THE PLUMBING CODE.** Updating the Plumbing Code of the City and County of Honolulu. (Bill passed first reading 7/6/16; Committee deferred action on 4/5/17; Bill consecutively referred to PWIS, ZH)
  3. **BILL 38 (2017) – RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS.** Addressing the recovery of construction and demolition debris. (Bill passed first reading 3/22/17)

4. [BILL 43 \(2017\)](#) – **RELATING TO THE MAINTENANCE OF CHANNELS, STREAMBEDS, STREAMBANKS AND DRAINAGEWAYS.** Amending the conditions a private stream owner is held to maintain, dredge and clear such stream. (Bill passed first reading 4/26/17)
