People need an affordable and humane solution to our feral cat population. ALL feral cats trapped and taken to the Humane Society – and without a microchip – ARE KILLED! The current Bill 22 CD 1 would provide the public with an alternative to the Humane Society's Trap-n-Kill policy. Last year, the Humane Society euthanized over 10,000 cats including 2,500 kittens that were 6-weeks old and younger. By supporting Trap-Neuter-Return with a \$10 certificate which most people can afford, we can begin to address our pet overpopulation challenges and the high euthanasia rate at the Hawaiian Humane Society. Bill 22 CD 1 is about saving lives!
