1. [RESOLUTION 17-237](#) – **ZERO-EMISSION ELECTRIC BUSES.** Urging the City Administration to implement a pilot program, adopt a comprehensive transition plan, and move to all zero-emission electric buses.
2. [RESOLUTION 17-238](#) – **ZERO-EMISSION ELECTRIC VEHICLE MOTOR POOL AND AUTOMOTIVE FLEET.** Urging the City Administration to initiate the transition to an all zero-emission electric vehicle motor pool and automotive fleet.
3. [RESOLUTION 17-285](#) – **NAMING OF HOOPUHI STREET IN WAIANAE.** Requesting the Department of Planning and Permitting to facilitate the official naming of Hoopuhi Street in Waianae.
4. [RESOLUTION 17-252](#) – **NAMING THE ALA NAPUNANI STREET BIKE LANES IN MEMORY OF ZACHARY MANAGO.** Naming the bike lanes along Ala Napunani Street in memory of Zachary Manago.
5. [BILL 77 \(2017\)](#) – **BICYCLE LANES.** Naming the Ala Napunani bicycle lanes in memory of Zachary Manago. (Bill 77 passed first reading 10/11/17)

[PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 77 \(2017\)](#) (Submitted by Councilmember Anderson) – The CD1 (OCS2017-0979/9/19/2017 3:53 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Adds subdivisions (2), (3), and (4) of Section 15-6.7(d), which were inadvertently omitted from the bill.
 - B. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
6. [BILL 82 \(2017\)](#) – **RELATING TO CHINATOWN, HONOLULU.** Amending the Complete Streets Ordinance, Chapter 14, Article 33 of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, to revise the procedure for the implementation of certain complete streets proposals in order to minimize their impacts on the economy of Chinatown. (Bill 82 passed first reading 10/11/17)

7. [BILL 85 \(2017\)](#) – **CAR SHARING.** Amending the ordinances relating to car sharing. (Bill 85 passed first reading 10/11/17)
8. [BILL 89 \(2017\)](#) – **RELATING TO TRAFFIC.** Addressing the management of traffic. (Bill 89 passed first reading 10/11/17)

[PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 89 \(2017\)](#) (Submitted by Councilmember Anderson) – The CD1 (OCS2017-1061/10/6/2017 1:25 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. In Section 15-3.1(b)(1), refers to the most recent edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices compiled by the Federal Highway Administration (instead of the “Revised Edition, 1978.”)
- B. In new Section 15-3.1(b)(4), changes the reference from “subdivision (a)(2)” to “subsection (a)(2),” and also changes the reference from “this paragraph” to “this subdivision.”
- C. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
