**Agenda Item 1 has been posted in anticipation of the action to be taken by the City Council at its meeting on Wednesday, January 31, 2018; and therefore, the Committee may or may not take action on the item or any amendments proposed thereto.**

1. [BILL 110 \(2017\)](#) and [CD1 TO BILL 110 \(2017\)](#) (Submitted by Councilmember Anderson) – **LARGE RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES**. Regulating for an interim period the issuance of building permits for the planning and development of large residential structures in residential districts. (The Bill, as amended to CD1, is scheduled for second reading and public hearing 1/31/18)

[BILL 110 \(2017\), CD1, FD1](#) (Submitted by Councilmember Ozawa) (The proposed FD1 is scheduled for consideration on 1/31/18)

2. **BILL 82 (2017) – RELATING TO CHINATOWN, HONOLULU**. Amending the Complete Streets Ordinance, Chapter 14, Article 33 of the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990, to revise the procedure for the implementation of certain complete streets proposals in order to minimize their impacts on the economy of Chinatown. (Bill 82 passed second reading and public hearing held 11/1/17)

[PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 82 \(2017\)](#) (Submitted by Councilmember Fukunaga) – The CD1 (OCS2017-1192/11/7/2017 10:43 AM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Corrects the definition of “directors” to refer to the director of facility maintenance (instead of facilities maintenance).
- B. Replaces proposed new ROH Section 14-33.3(f) with the following:  
  
“Based on Chinatown’s unique architectural character and cultural history, no curb extension bulb-outs or bicycle-sharing stations may be implemented in the core historic precinct of the Chinatown special district, as designated in Section 21-9.60-2 and on Exhibit 21-9.9.”
- C. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
