MINUTES OF JANUARY 24, 2018 AND FEBRUARY 14, 2018 REGULAR MEETINGS

1. **COMMUNICATION D-82 – KAPOLEI INTERCEPTOR SEWER.** From the Department of Design and Construction, requesting consideration of dedication documents conveying Grant of Sewer Easements 2119 and 10193; Grant of Sewer Easements 2120 and 8608 (por); Grant of Sewer Easement 8608 (por) (Lot 316); Grant of Sewer Easement 2121 (por); and Grant of Sewer Easement 2121 (por) (Lot 319) for public use in Ewa.
2. **COMMUNICATION D-121 – KAPOLEI – KAPOLEI PARKWAY AND KAMOKILA BOULEVARD.** From the Department of Design and Construction, requesting consideration of Deed conveying roadway Lot 16014-B; Grant of Flowage Easement 10336 (por) Lot 347-A; Grant of Flowage Easement 10336 (por) Lot 18771; Grant of Drainage Easement 11062; Grant of Sewer Easement 9550; and Grant of Sewer Easement 9558 for public use in Ewa.
3. **RESOLUTION 18-39 – REHABILITATION OF THE CITY-OWNED PORTION OF KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY NEAR HEEIA.** Urging the City Administration to expedite rehabilitation of the City-owned portion of Kamehameha Highway between Kahekili Highway in Kahaluu and Haiku Road in Kaneohe.
4. **RESOLUTION 18-40 – POTHOLE REPAIR SCHEDULE FOR THE CITY-OWNED PORTION OF KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY NEAR HEEIA.** Urging the City Administration to develop a pothole repair schedule for the City-owned portion of Kamehameha Highway between Kahekili Highway in Kahaluu and Haiku Road in Kaneohe.
5. **RESOLUTIONS 18-53 – DEVELOP ON-ISLAND RECYCLING FACILITIES.** Urging the City Administration to develop on-island recycling facilities.
6. **RESOLUTION 18-61 – GRANTING OF EASEMENT TO HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC. ABUTTING KAPOLEI PARKWAY.** Approving the granting of easement to Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc. abutting Kapolei Parkway, Kapolei, Oahu, Hawaii (TMK: 9-1-160:018). (Transmitted by Communication [D-132](#))

7. **BILL 108 (2017) – RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.** Protecting the environment by reducing litter and the improper disposal of waste and refuse in the City, and Oahu's land-based contributions to marine debris, by adopting a comprehensive program to systematically and measurably reduce litter through prevention, enhanced enforcement, clean up and increased public awareness. (Bill passed first reading on 12/6/17)

PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 108 (2017) – (Submitted by Councilmember Fukunaga) - The CD1 (OCS2018-0095/2/2/2018 3:53 PM) makes the following amendments:

- A. Amends proposed new ROH Section 9-1. ("Public refuse containers") to add a requirement that all new or replacement refuse containers installed by the city in any public facility or other City-owned property shall be located adjacent to containers for recyclable materials that are designated with the universal recycling symbol and other pictorial markings indicating the types of materials to be placed in the container. Provides that "recyclable materials" mean the same as defined in ROH Section 9-1.2.

Amends the last sentence of the proposed new section by replacing "closeable lids" with "containers."

- B. Amends proposed new ROH Section 9-1. ("Determination of violations") to provide that reasonable evidence that may be considered by the department in investigating complaints of illegal dumping or related violations includes photographs and video recordings.
- C. Deletes SECTION 4 of the bill, which would prohibit property owners in areas provided with manual refuse collection from placing refuse in open containers or in containers made of nondurable materials such as plastic film, paper or cardboard.

Renumbers bill subsequent bill sections accordingly.

- D. Makes miscellaneous technical and nonsubstantive amendments.
