1. **[BILL 50 \(2018\)](#) – BUILDING PERMITS FOR LARGE RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES.** Amending Ordinance 18-6, relating to regulating for an interim period the issuance of building permits for the planning and development of large residential structures in residential districts. (Bill 50 passed first reading 7/11/18)
2. **[BILL 53 \(2018\)](#) – RELATING TO THE BUILDING CODE.** Amending the Building Code to strengthen enforcement provisions for buildings and structures erected, constructed, enlarged, altered, repaired, moved, improved, removed, or converted without the necessary permits. (Bill 53 passed first reading 7/11/18)
